Commission on all sales is 20%

Commissions are payable at time of sale. HEA and Jay Smith training will also receive a 20% commission from any horse sold 90 days after the horse leaves the care of HEA and Jay Smith Training if the sale was instituted by us. We also receive a 10% commission payable at the time of sale, for any horse sold while in our care, regardless of who is the agent for the sale.

All services are to be paid for in advance. Board and training is due on the 1st day of each month and a late fee of \$20 will be applied on the 10th if full payment has not been received. Any unpaid balances will be charged to the credit card on file on the 10th of each month if payment has not been received.
